

## **SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER/FACILITATOR**

The Sunday School Teacher/Facilitator is responsible for co-teaching a Sunday School Class every week with a Teacher who is part of a roster of rotating volunteers. Classes teach the same lesson over a 4-6 week period, through different mediums – Movie, Story, Art, Drama, Cooking and Games. The Teacher/Facilitator would need to be comfortable working in these mediums, although the Volunteer Teachers often have the skills to take leadership when required.

Students generally attend class together and their ages range from pre-school to 6<sup>th</sup> grade. If there are enough students, classes are broken down according to age (usually with the Story Workshops)

Teaching materials and curriculum are adapted from the Rotation Sunday School model and must be pre-approved by the Pastor. The position is supported by a team of Teacher Volunteers as well as the Church's Nurture Team.

The Teacher/Facilitator must be comfortable teaching curriculum that emphasizes Christian faith as practiced through Reformed Theology. The position is supported by a team of interns and volunteers as well as the Nurture Team and the Pastor.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES**

- Work with Pastor and Nurture Team to develop a Teacher Volunteer Base
- Mentor and Train teachers
- Be prepared to teach every Sunday beginning in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in September until the Sunday before Christmas Eve and the third Sunday in January until the third Sunday in June.
- Work with the Pastor in developing creative workshops that underscore the curriculum
- Ensure the Sunday School Rooms are set-up for teaching the week's lesson (e.g. teaching materials and supplies).
- Reach out to absent students and parents

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- A practicing Christian
- Enjoy and appreciate children and support their growth in personal and spiritual matters
- Detail oriented with developed organizational skills
- Dependable
- A willingness to learn and adhere to the Church's philosophy of ministry and the beliefs of the Reformed tradition
- A commitment to see students growing in the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ and the gospel of God's grace
- Experience in working with children
- Experience in children's ministry helpful but not required

**HOURS** – 3-6 hours a week (other than 2 hours on Sunday, the hours are flexible)

This is a Part-time, Non-Exempt position

**SALARY** – \$18 hour
